- **Help plan and implement the schoolwide initiatives by attending 3 meetings** (held on Sunday afternoons during the school year, 3:00-5:00).
- **Work once a cycle** at Luke Center (approximately 3-4 hrs per month, at a time slot that works for the student according to her/his schedule).
- **Purchase a Luke Leader T-shirt** (shirts are \$12 and help to identify you as a leader on our campus!).
